

## **Uíge: Lightning Kills Two Women**

Uíge, 03/17 - Two women passed away and another was seriously injured in the wards of Papelão and Dunga, outskirts of Uíge city, as a result of lightning caused by the rains that fell on Tuesday in the region, informed the families of the victims.

The victims are Maria Dregina and Maria Morena, 58 and 40 years of age, respectively, both natives of Bembe district, with each having left seven children. One lightning struck the first victim at home, whilst the other was thumped on her way from the garden.

The other victim who was seriously struck is Deolinda Pedro of 26 years of age, native of Quimbele district, currently under health care, but out of danger and recovering.
