

Lightning kills man in ECape

A 40-year-old man died after he was struck by lightning at Mthontsasa village in Lusikisiki, Eastern Cape police said on Wednesday.

Three other people, all family members of the deceased, were also hit, said police spokesperson Captain Mduduzi Godlwana.

"They suffered no injuries but are being treated for shock in the Holy Cross hospital in Lusikisiki," he said.

"The family members were at home when the lightning struck at about 8pm on Tuesday."

Their hut was burnt to ashes.
